ISSUED WATER USAGE WARNING – for Customers supplied by Goldenfields Water in the following areas.

- Tenandra area including: Rural customers east of Junee, including Eurongilly,
 Tenandra and Wantabadgery, and the villages of Illabo, Bethungra, Wantabadgery
- Cartwrights Hill area including: Rural customers in Sebastopol, Mimosa, parts of Rannock, Marrar and Old Junee

Goldenfields Water County Council has issued a water usage **warning** for its customers in the above areas; due to exceeding our capacity to supply the demand following the continued, extreme weather conditions. Reservoir levels have not been able to recover to maintain supply, in the case of Cartwrights Hill a power outage on Wednesday 23rd of January contributed to the extreme supply conditions.

We apologise for any inconvenience and thank our customers for their patience and cooperation during this time.

Goldenfields Water advises customers to ensure they minimise their use where possible, do their own inspections of their property's water supply to ensure no leakages or bursts and to report any concerns immediately to our 24 hour **Emergency Contact 1800 800 917.**
