The project will include:

- Construction of a new concrete standpipe reservoir
- A new pump station
- A new supply main and renewed reticulation main

- Allow for future expansion

TIMELINE

October 2022

- Killard Infrastructure commence pipeline construction
- Quay Civil commence reservoir construction

May 2023

- Goldenfields Water commence pump station construction
- Quay Civil complete reservoir construction

July 2023

- Goldenfields Water complete pump station construction

August 2023

- Killard Infrastructure complete pipeline construction
- Total project to be completed

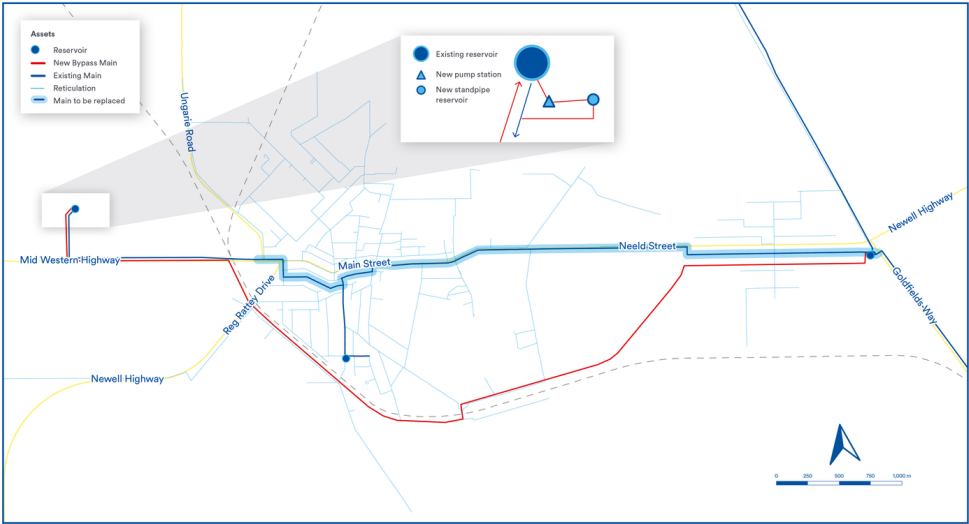
