The adoption of Minute 10/034 which capped the increase in access and consumption charges in 2010/11 to 3% negatively impacted on the budgeted operating result by \$397,401. The initial draft budget also included 5% increases in both access and consumption charges for the following two years (2011/12 and 2012/13). To maintain the required yields in these years increased adjustments of 10% in access charges and 7.5% in consumption charges were required in 2011/12.

The necessity to round down consumption charges to the nearest cent meant that an exact increase of 3% could not be applied. The table below provides more detail.

The Title for Lot 21 DP 1030750, being the original area of Cootamundra No.1 Reservoir, was received from the Department of Commerce with the South West Tablelands Water Supply Titles.

MINUTES for the MEETING of GOLDENFIELDS WATER COUNTY COUNCIL held in the TEMORA office on 24 JUNE 2010.

Cootamundra No.1 was handed over to Cootamundra Shire in the early 1990's with State Property being asked to finalise the land matters, including additional land and easements. SWTWS undertook to do the land matters at no cost to Cootamundra Shire Council, a debt which GWCC inherited. While the additional lands and easements remain with Commerce's Legal Branch to be resolved, the original Lot 21 DP 1030750 was issued in Goldenfields name.

Under the provisions of the SWTWS Repeal Act 1997 or the Ministerial Orders Goldenfields can not regard this Title as an asset. Only those assets in SWTWS and NRCC Water custody are able to become GWCC assets. This Title was issued in GWCC's name in a clear error by State Property.

GWCC's staff were reluctant to take custody of the Title and have consulted with Council's Solicitor, Cootamundra Shire Council's General Manager and Commerce's Principal Solicitor, Elizabeth Stewart. It is considered that the best course of action to amend the error is for GWCC's Solicitor to prepare a transfer at no cost to Cootamundra Shire Council.

Pursuant to Section 377(1) of the Local Government Act 1993, a resolution of Council is required to authorise the transfer.

Recommendation

Of particular interest to Goldenfields was the address by the Hon Phil Costa, Minister for Water in which he spoke of the <u>Inquiry into secure and sustainable</u> <u>urban water supply and sewerage services in non-metropolitan NSW (the</u> Inquiry) and the impending <u>Murray – Darling Basin Plan (the Plan)</u>.

With respect to the Inquiry the Minister advised that he is "*in the final stages of forming a response*" and that this response "*will be presented very shortly*". There was no indication as to what the response may contain or what timeframe "shortly" means.

The Murray-Darling Basin Plan is due for release around the end of July with the Minister stating that he has had no input or insight into what will be contained in the Plan.
